ZAYN APPEARS TO GUSH ABOUT GIGI HADID ON NEW BALLAD

Zayn Malik has shared a preview of a new song which is seemingly about his girlfriend Gigi Hadid being the only woman he needs. The former One Direction star - who has been dating the stunning model for over two years - shared the snippet of the track on his Instagram profile on Tuesday. On the track, which could appear on the singer's next record, Zayn belts: "She's all the woman I need." He's also shared a video of him playing the acoustic guitar on the photo-sharing app, with the caption: "jammin (sic)" Over the top of the instrument, he sings: "I see you every night, always on my mind. Always on my mind/I know you are mine." It comes after the 'Still Got Time' hitmaker registered a new song called 'Hurt'. Zayn appears as

the owner of the track on a BMI listing, whilst a host of major songwriters and producer BURNS have been credited for their involvement. Among the names are Andrew Watt and Ali Tamposi - who co-wrote Camila Cabello's huge hit 'Havana' - Chloe Angelides, known for working with Selena Gomez and Demi Lovato, and Britney Spears collaborator The DJ Burns. The track, when released, will follow two mega collaborations from the 24-year-old musician in the form of 'Dusk Till Dawn' with Sia and 'I Don't Wanna Live Forever' with Taylor Swift. Zayn has been keeping his cards close to his chest when it comes to his second record, but admitted he's "kind of finalized it". He said: "This record, I've kind of finalized it. But there's always ideas. Every day I find

another song that I'm swapping out with another one. That's why the album date hasn't really come yet. Even though the album is pretty much there, and I have the material, I'm still changing things here and there. It's not necessary in my head when I work on a song whether it's for a new project or whether it's for this." Zayn promised fans that a tour is "definitely on the cards" for his second album. The 'Pillowtalk' hitmaker didn't head out on the road in promotion of his debut solo record 'Mind of Mine' in 2016, but now he has more material under his belt with the new LP on the way, he's "excited to start rehearsing" his live show.



Justin Bieber to release new Spanish tune with J Balvin

Justin Bieber has recorded a new Spanish tune with J Balvin and regular collaborator Skrillex. The 'Sorry' hitmaker has been on a break since axing the rest of his 'Purpose World Tour' in July due to exhaustion, but while he's been taking some much needed time off, he's also been preparing for his comeback. 'Bonita' hitmaker Balvin, who is known for his reggaeton style, told The Sun newspaper: "I know he is working right now. We have a song together which is not out yet. I think it will come soon. We recorded that last year. "It's a real dope song, produced by Skrillex, and hopefully it's going to be on my album." The track follows Bieber's remix of smash hit 'Despacito', which the 23-year-old heartthrob - who is back dating his on/off girlfriend Selena Gomez - wanted to sing in the language. The track by Luis Fonsi and Daddy Yankee was the first song that was primarily in Spanish to top the Billboard Hot 100 since a 1996 remix of 'Macarena', and Luis - who sings on the track alongside the 'As Long As You Love Me' hitmaker - previously revealed it was Justin's decision to use the Spanish version rather than an English one they had recorded. He said: "The funny thing is we actually have a version of the song fully recorded in English, and he knew that. Instead of using that, he decided to use the Spanish version, even though he doesn't speak Spanish himself and made sure he was phonetically pronouncing the words correctly." Meanwhile, Justin skipped the Grammy Awards in New York City last weekend, to spend time with his friends. The 'What Do You Mean?' singer was instead spotted hanging out with his pals and a few fans in Santa Monica, California. An eyewitness told 'Entertainment Tonight' that Justin was "in a low key, good mood and was very sweet". In his absence, Luis Fonsi and Daddy Yankee still took the stage with vocalist and Miss Universe 2006 Zuleyka Rivera to perform a rendition 'Despacito'. According to Luis, Justin - whose single received three Grammy nominations - declined his invitation to perform.



Naughty Boy to finish Cheryl Tweedy track today

Naughty Boy is heading into the studio today to put the finishing touches to his song for Cheryl Tweedy. The 'Runnin' hitmaker previously revealed he teamed up with the former Girls Aloud star on a track for her new record, which will be her first since the arrival of her little boy Bear - whom she has with boyfriend Liam Payne - in March. The 33-year-old record producer - whose real name is Shahid Khan - can't wait for fans of the 'Call My Name' hitmaker to hear the "great" track they've produced together. Appearing on 'Lorraine' yesterday he said: "She is a lovely girl. We have recently met and we have written a song for her new album and we are really happy. "She is her own entity and she is in a good place. "People are wanting her to come back and hear what she can do next." Shahid - who has helped launch the careers of Sam Smith and Emeli Sande, to name a few - has also revealed he's on the lookout for the next big star to work with. Referring to TV talent shows like 'The X Factor', he said: "I feel there's still someone out there who's not ready to apply for a TV show. That's what I'm ready to hear. "From meeting Emeli

Sande and Sam Smith you understand what real talent is, and it's not chasing anything, it's an innate desire for your music to live." It comes after Rak-Su were spotted with Cheryl and Naughty Boy at the same recording space. The X Factor champions - made up of childhood friends Mustafa Rahimtulla, Ashley Fongho, Jamaal Shurland and Myles Stephenson - already collaborated with the producer and Wyclef Jean on 'Dimelo', and were an instant hit with Cheryl when they were on the talent show. Cheryl last released music in 2014 in the form of her 'Only Human' album, and to make sure she comes back with a bang, Cheryl recruited Naughty Boy. It was previously revealed the brunette beauty had kickstarted her return to the music industry when she registered a new song entitled 'That's My Song'. Her Girls Aloud bandmate Nicola Roberts was listed as a songwriter, alongside Triple 8 band member Iain James. And Cheryl has also been in the studio with Afro-beat producers Team Salut.

Catfish and the Bottlemen and George Ezra for Boardmasters

Catfish and the Bottlemen and George Ezra have been announced as headliners for Boardmasters Festival. Van McCann and co will close the Main Stage at Watergate Bay in Newquay, Cornwall on Friday August 10, whilst the 'Budapest' hitmaker will bring the festivities to an end on Sunday August 12. The 'Cocoon' rockers and the 24-year-old singer/songwriter join previously confirmed Saturday headliners The Chemical Brothers. Also joining the bill is grime legend Kano - who headlined the music and surfing extravaganza's Unleashed Stage in 2016 - who will make his UK festival exclusive at Watergate Bay. Also on the bill are Years & Years - who haven't released new music since 2016 - who look set to make a comeback this summer. And Rag'n'Bone Man, Rae Morris, Friendly Fires, MK and Raye have also been announced, with many more acts to be unveiled in the coming months. 'Galvanize' hitmakers Chemical Brothers - electronic pioneers Ed Simons and Tom Rowlands - will perform on the main stage on August 11. The NME Award-nominated festival is held between August 8 and August 12, 2018 across Fistral Beach and Watergate Bay in Newquay, South West England. Also on the bill are Craig David, Annie Mac, Fat Freddy's Drop, Declan McKenna, Tom Walker, Craig David, Sam Fender, The Horrors, The Amazons and Bicep. Andrew Topham, Boardmasters Festival Director, said: "We are delighted to announce The Chemical Brothers as our first headline act for Boardmasters 2018. Following another sell-out year which saw the biggest Boardmasters ever this summer, we are excited to bring more of the most exciting names in music to Cornwall next August. Boardmasters' unique fusion of the very best in international surfing and music helps to keep Cornwall firmly on the map as the festival sees unprecedented growth year on year. Sigrid can count Dame Helen Mirren as a fan. The rising Norwegian star has revealed the 72-year-old screen legend told her she loves her music when they met on TV's 'The Graham Norton Show' recently. Sigrid - whose full name is Sigrid Solbakk Raabe revealed: "I talked to her backstage and she is very, very cool. She liked my music, apparently she had listened to me before. "It was really nice to meet her and hang out." Sigrid - this year's BBC Music Sound of 2017 poll winner - has also revealed that after topping the charts with her latest single 'Strangers', she has set her sights on recording a song for the next 'Eurovision Song Contest' hopeful from her country. She told The Sun newspaper: "I don't think I would participate in 'Eurovision', but I would love to write a song for it. "I don't think I would do well in 'Eurovision' because I don't think jeans and a T-shirt is a thing, you have to wear sequins and a costume. "But it would have to be for Norway, obviously. Do it for my country. "It would be so fun - I want to go to the final. I'm going to make it happen." Sigrid became prominent after the release of the single 'Don't Kill My Vibe' last year, and was "honored" to follow in the footsteps of the likes of Jessie J, Ellie Goulding and Adele who previously won the prestigious BBC poll. Sigrid said previously: "It's a lot to take in to have won something as prestigious as BBC Music Sound Of. I feel honored as there are so many other artists I look up to who have won this before me, and honestly, I'm just really happy and proud of what my team and I have achieved together. I'm from a small town called ?lesund in Norway. "I'm still 21 and it's quite crazy to get this recognition. I'm very excited about the year ahead and sharing new music with everyone. Jared Leto hints next 30 Seconds to Mars LP 'could be the last'

A Jared Leto has hinted 30 Seconds to Mars' next record could be "their last album" for a while. The 'Suicide Squad' actor admits the band leave big gaps between records, and says fans might have to wait a long time before they put out a follow-up to their forthcoming fifth studio album. According to the Daily Star newspaper, Leto said: "We're really slow at putting albums out. "I don't mean we're never putting music out again but this may be the last album at least for a while, until I feel I need a collection of songs to say something." The 46-year-old hunk recently teased the new album - their first since 2013's 'Love, Lust, Faith and Dreams' - is on the way, and they have a new single dropping "soon". Leto shared a photograph of his bandmates in their spacious studio on his Instagram Story recently, with the caption:

"The longer you work on a song the longer it takes to finish "New album coming sooooooon! (sic) He also posted two black and white photos of himself, and wrote: "Swipe to the see the frontal having a good Saturday? Almost done with the next single (sic)" The US band's last release was the single 'Walk On Water'. Leto previously revealed the record will be "surprising" as it is very futuristic. He said: "The album is, I think, going to be very surprising to people. There's quite a lot of different musical styles on the album, it's a very modern album and a break from the past we are incredibly excited about it. It has a lot of energy and we've spent years working on it, exploring new ideas." And the model admitted that they have "shattered expectations" by breaking a few rules. — Bang Showbiz
