



Disick plans to remain in rehab until early 2016

Scott Disick plans to remain in rehab for 90 days. The 32-year-old star has reportedly promised ex-girlfriend Kourtney Kardashian, 36, and her mother, Kris Jenner, he will continue his treatment at the Cliffside Malibu in California until early January after they warned him they would fight his bid to gain joint custody of their children, Mason, five, Penelope, three, and Reign, 10 months, if he leaves the program early. A source close to the 'Keeping Up with the Kardashians' star, who checked into the luxurious treatment center more than two weeks ago after three brief attempts to seek help for his drug and alcohol issues in the past, said: "Kris and Kourtney have set the terms that he is to stay in treatment for a total of 90 days, with the option to do outpatient after one month. "They told him that anything less is not acceptable and will prevent him from obtaining joint custody. "He was left with no other choice. Kris also told him that all of his friends are enablers and he has to get rid of them if he wants to really get better. He knows that he needs to 86 all of his buddies from his life." The Kardashian family matriarch, 59, brought Scott's three children to visit him at the facility this week and he plans to do everything he can to get his life back on track. The insider told gossip website RadarOnline.com: "Scott is actually taking this seriously. He told the them all that he will do whatever they want him to do so that he can remain a full-time father to his children."

Allen pens song in memory of late son



Lily Allen has revealed her late baby son inspired the song she wrote for the movie 'Pan'. The 30-year-old singer penned 'Something's Not Right' in memory of the child she tragically delivered stillborn six months into her pregnancy in 2010 after contracting a viral infection. After the birth, the musician was admitted to hospital and treated for septicemia. Lily - who has two daughters, Ethel, three, and two year old Marnie with her husband Sam Cooper - took to Twitter to make a series of deeply personal posts on the site and direct fans to a YouTube page where you can listen to the track from the Hugh Jackman led fantasy film. The pop star also urged her followers to donate to Sands, the still-birth and neonatal charity. On Tuesday she wrote: "5 years ago today I was admitted to hospital. 4 days later I delivered a beautiful baby boy, but sadly he didn't make it ... It's unlike me to discuss this sort of thing so publicly but I wrote this song in his memory when writing something for @pan-movie ... please listen and if you fancy it, you could donate in his memory love, lil x (sic)" In 'Something's Not Right', Lily sings the heartfelt lyrics: "Something's not right / There aren't many stars in the sky tonight / Something's not right / Cause I know that it's day but it's dark outside / And I feel a weight in my heart tonight. "We had forever / We never got it together / They kept telling me that it was unlikely / All I had to do was keep you beside me." Previously discussing the emotional torment she went through due to the stillbirth, Lily revealed: "It was horrendous ... I have dealt with it, you know, as being at one with it. But it's not something that you get over."

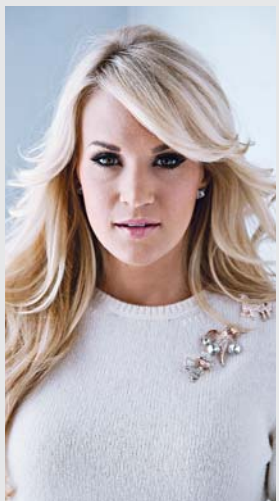


Spears wants Adele ticket swap
