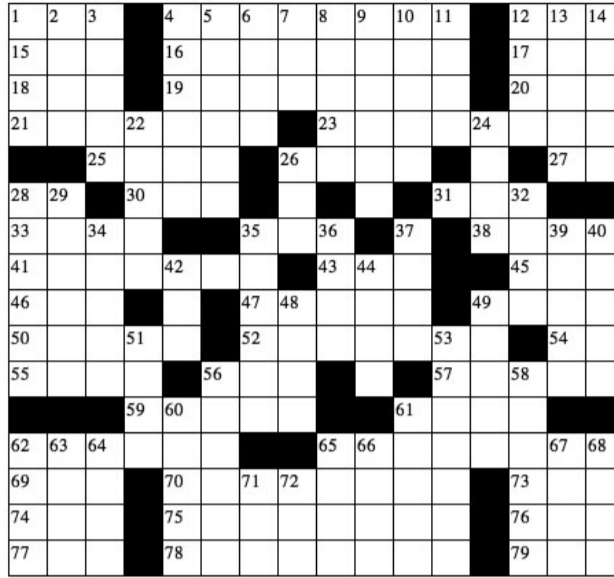

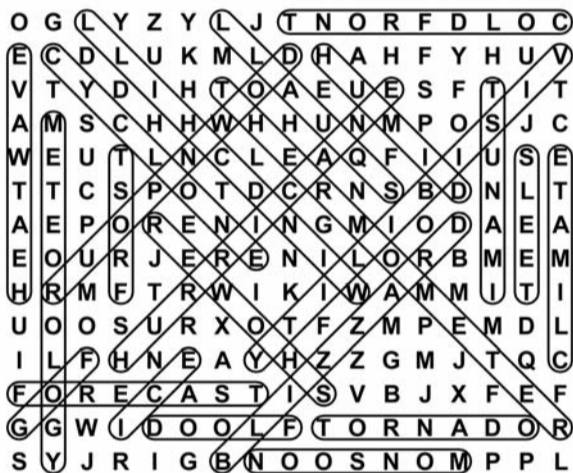

- Cooking utensil consisting of a wide metal vessel.

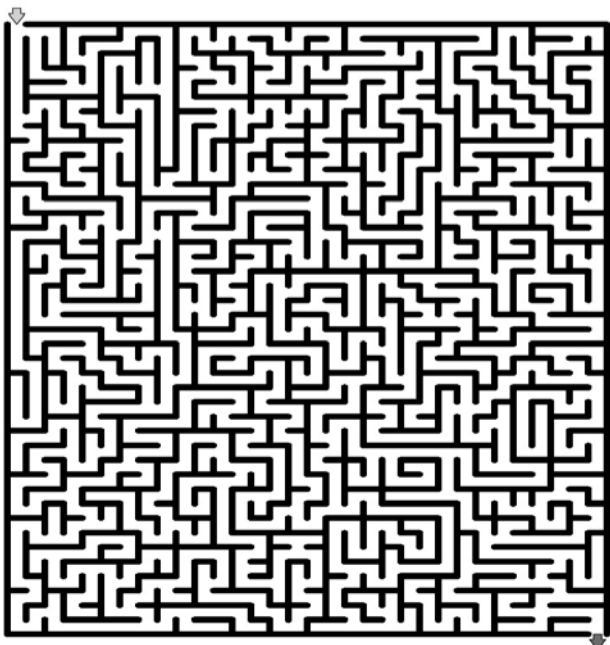

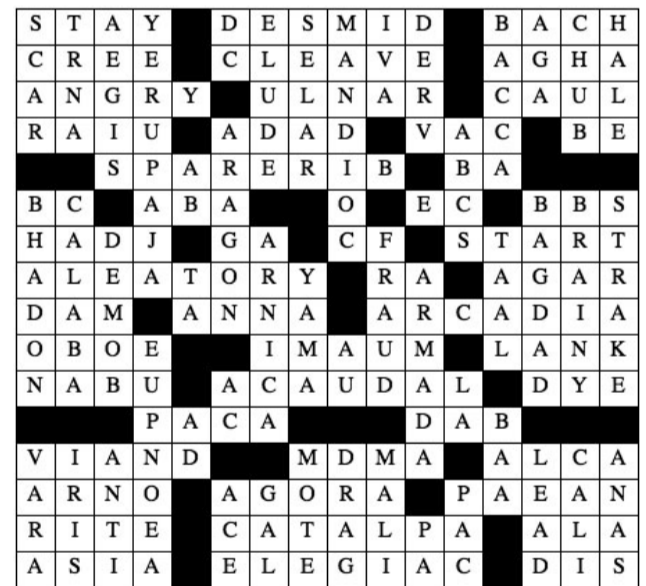
