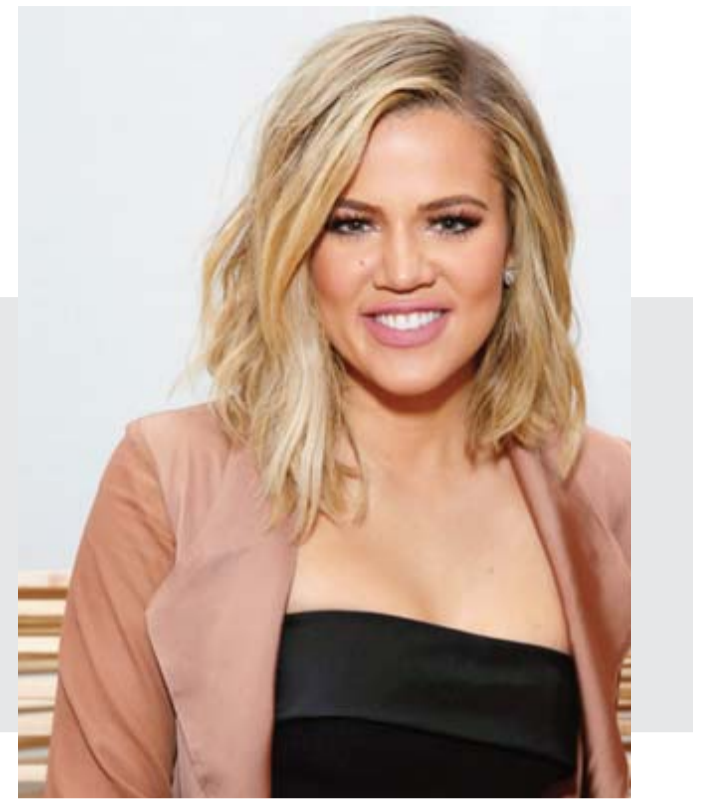


Khloe takes swipe at estranged husband Lamar

Khloe Kardashian has seemingly taken a swipe at her estranged husband Lamar Odom in a cryptic post on Instagram. The 31-year-old reality TV star, who is currently in the process of divorcing the former basketball player, posted a quote on her Instagram account on Saturday that seemed targeted at her estranged husband, who collapsed in a brothel in Nevada in 2015. The quote read: "They start missing you when they fail at replacing you." The curvaceous celebrity captioned the now-deleted image: "You don't know what you got till it's gone. I say, you knew what you had, you just never thought it could slip away. We often take for granted the things that deserve our gratitude the most. We do this with both people and material possessions. The problem is many people do not realize this until it is too late. Cheryl Fernandez-Versini and Liam Payne are reportedly trying for a baby. The celebrity couple, who started dating eight months ago, are keen to start a family, with a source close to the One Direction singer claiming Cheryl is happier now than she has been since her marriage to soccer player Ashley Cole. An insider explained: "It's very serious now between Cheryl and Liam and they have been talking among close friends about starting a family. Cheryl is happier than she's been since the good days of her marriage to Ashley Cole." Although the source admitted that the duo are still in the early stages of their high-profile romance, the 32-year-old singer and Liam, 22, both see it as a long-term commitment. The source told The Sun on Sunday newspaper: "She's content and while they're in the honeymoon period, this feels like a connection for the future." Earlier this month, Cheryl's showbiz pal Tinchy Stryder - who became good friends with the singer when he supported her on tour in 2012 - said he hopes the pair find happiness together. He said: "If that's what makes her happy then good for her, good for him. It's just good for them, man. If she's happy and looking well, there's nothing wrong with that. Hopefully she stays happy." The rap star also praised the brunette beauty for being "bubbly and laid back". He said: "She's really cool. What you see is what you get in a way. She's bubbly and laid back, she's cool." Kendall Jenner's close shave

Kendall Jenner starting shaving her legs when she was seven. The 'Keeping Up With the Kardashians' star was left with bloody pins in her early years when she took a razor to her bare flesh after she walked in on her half-sister Kim Kardashian West, 35, in the shower shaving her own legs. She explained to Look magazine: "I once walked in on Kim shaving her legs in the shower. I was only seven and I was like, 'When can I do that?' And she was like, 'Not for a long time Kendall.' Depp reportedly feels he is 'too trusting'

The 53-year-old Hollywood icon is said to have opened up about his failed marriage to actress Amber Heard during the after-party for his rock band The Hollywood Vampires during their recent gig in Bucharest, Romania. A source shared: "If Johnny was under any stress, he didn't show it. He was quite relaxed, sipping beers and chatting with his friends. He even talked about Amber a little - but he clearly feels that he is the innocent party in all of this." Johnny has been accused of being physically and verbally abusive towards his estranged wife during their marriage, but the acclaimed actor is confident he will ultimately be cleared of the accusations. A source told the Sunday Mirror newspaper: "Johnny told the restaurant owner he's always had a weakness for being too trusting, and said that was what had caused his problems. Obviously Amber is making some shocking claims about him, but he gave the impression of someone who wasn't worried. He doesn't accept the things that have been said. He also said their relationship was great until they got married." Despite the controversy surrounding him, Johnny was reported to have looked relaxed and happy at the after-party. The source added: "Johnny was in a great mood. He was chatting to the girls at the party, and certainly didn't seem to have the weight of the world on his shoulders." This comes shortly after it was confirmed that Amber's restraining order against her husband had been extended. The 'Magic Mike XXL' star filed for the court order against Johnny at the end of May after filing for divorce from him a few days earlier. The restraining order - which was originally granted when Amber claimed Johnny hurled an iPhone at the actress' face - will now stay in place until August 15. Johnny has denied the accusations made against him.

Calvin is planning a break-up song about Taylor

Calvin Harris is reportedly planning a break-up song about his split from Taylor Swift. The Scottish DJ is apparently working on a song concerning his abrupt break-up from the 'Blank Space' hitmaker, and is considering drafting in Kanye West and Rihanna for the recording sessions. A source said: "Kanye is up for doing something with Calvin and Rihanna and now Calvin's no longer with Taylor anything is possible." It has been reported, too, that Taylor's new romance with actor Tom Hiddleston has led Calvin to have a rethink about the album. The insider told The Sun on Sunday newspaper: "Calvin feels that talking publicly is not the way to go, but expressing things in music is the better option. He's currently working on some new music and has been milling over some tunes about heartbreak, deceit and lost love." This comes shortly after it was reported Taylor dumped Calvin over the phone, thereby mirroring how her ex-boyfriend Joe Jonas ended his relationship with the chart-topping singer in October 2008. Taylor, 26, is said to have called Calvin to end their relationship at some point after he was injured in a car crash. The singer was rumored to have been very vague with her former lover, simply telling him that she just needed space. However, Taylor previously slated Joe for ending their romance in a 27-second phone call. Speaking in 2008, the blonde beauty said: "It's all right - I'm cool. You know what, it's like, when I find that person that is right for me, he'll be wonderful. When I look at that person, I'm not even going to remember the boy who broke up with me over the phone in 27 seconds when I was 18. I'm sorry. I had to. [The split] was, like, a record, I think, for how quick. I looked at the call log - it was like 27 seconds. That's got to be a record."



Ariana Grande talks 'perks' of fame

Ariana Grande thinks avoiding chores is one of the best "perks" of fame. The 'Dangerous Woman' hitmaker is "embarrassed" by her lack of domesticity but insists it is largely because she is away working a lot of the time. She said: "I'm embarrassed but I can't remember the last time I did the dishes or took out the trash. I'm on the road so much and in hotels all the time. I guess one of the perks of travelling so much for work is you get out of chores." Despite starting her career when she was just 13 years old, Ariana feels "super-lucky" and doesn't think she missed out on her childhood. She told heat magazine: "I just feel super-lucky. My childhood was a bit different, but really normal in a lot of ways too." The 22-year-old star is a big fan of Miley Cyrus because of her confidence and daring nature, and hopes she can set a similar example to her own fans. She said: "I love Miley's confidence and how she tries new things all the time. Like her, I'm really trying to push myself to try new things too... I think it's really important to stick up for what you believe in and what's right. I am so proud of myself for seeing that I am strong enough to take control and feel comfortable with who I am. Posner is set to release a book of poetry

The star - who recently reach number one on the Billboard Mix/Show Airplay chart and number four on the Billboard Hot 100 in America with 'I Took A Pill In Ibiza' - has revealed a new side to his career following the release his second album. Speaking to BANG Showbiz, he said: "I just put out my album 'At Night, Alone' and another album, 'Secret Project' coming soon before the end of this year and I wrote a book of poetry that's coming out soon." The 28-year-old musician made his big comeback this year following a quiet six years since his hit track 'Cooler Than Me' was released and he has shared his struggle to recreate its success; while writing songs for other artists such as Justin Bieber and Labrinth. He said: "I made two albums that got shelved by my label; my songs just didn't sell as well I guess. There was a gap in between for you guys, for me I was always with myself, I was always making music. But basically I was just making music that was less popular and my fans; they know all the stuff in between. I don't know why, some stuff gets more popular than others. I wish I knew why; I would make all popular stuff."
