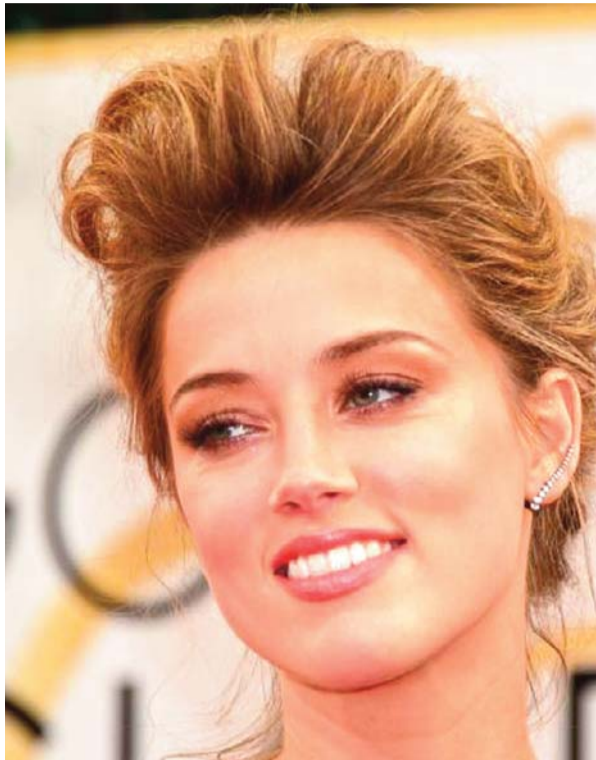


# Mel B car broken into outside her home

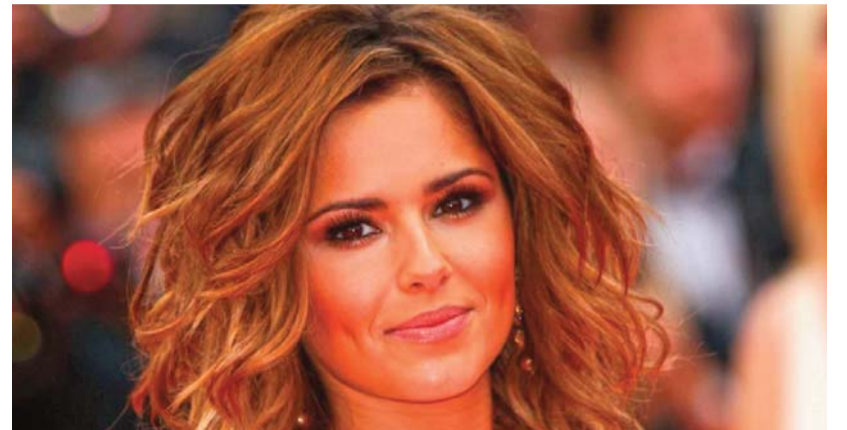

It happens to so many women you know, when it happens in your home behind closed doors with someone you love it's not straightforward. "If a stranger did this as it was pointed out to me if a stranger did this it would be a no brainer." "Just as a woman having gone through this in the public stage, in the public arena that I did it, I have a unique opportunity to remind other women this doesn't have to be the way it is, you don't have to do it alone, you're not alone. We can change this." Amber rounded off her heart-warming speech by urging women to "speak up", in order to help eliminate violence against women. The 'Justice League' actress said: "Speak up, speak up. Raise your voice, your voice is the most powerful thing and we, together, as women standing shoulder to shoulder cannot and will not any longer accept silence."

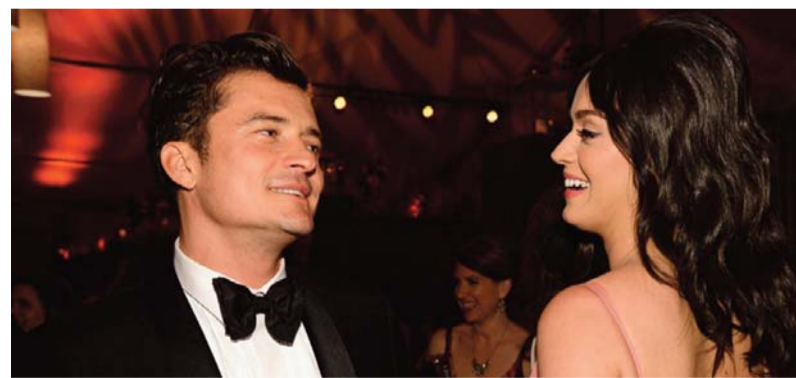
# Paris Hilton says she is not just a 'dumb blonde'
