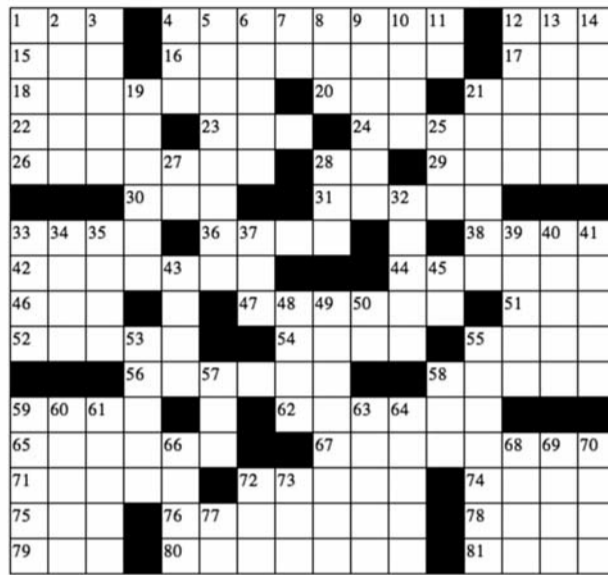

- The basic unit of money in Nigeria.

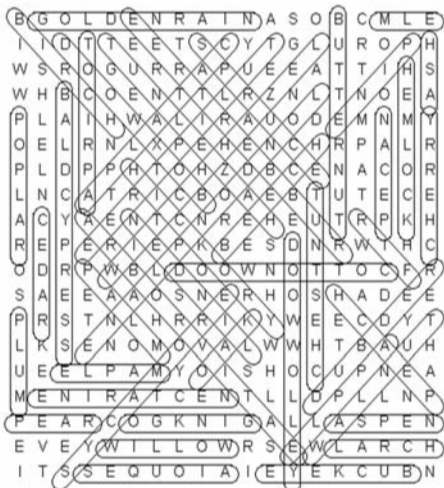
- Plant with an elongated head of broad stalked leaves resembling celery.

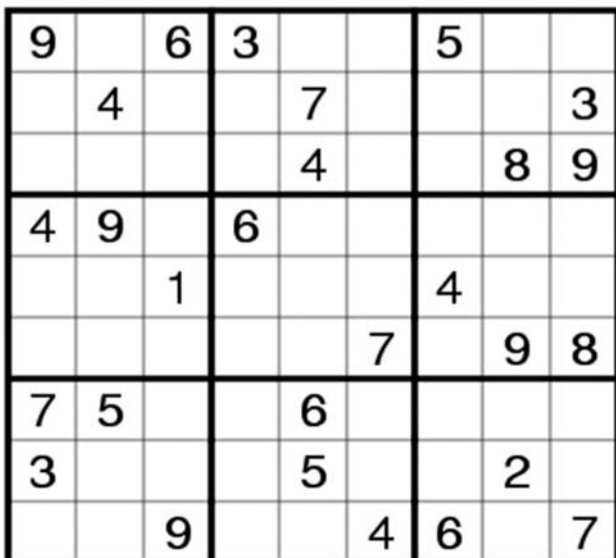
