INVESTING IN HUMAN BASE OF MODERN HEALTH CARE: MINISTER

KUWAIT: Kuwaiti Health Minister Dr Jamal Al-Harbi yesterday emphasized the significance of investing in the human element as the base of modern health systems. This was the essence of a statement delivered on behalf of the minister by the ministry's Acting Undersecretary Dr Mohammad Al-Khashti, also Assistant Undersecretary for Planning and Quality Affairs to a conference held on the occasion of the 2nd Biomedical Laboratory Science Day.

He added that the conference reflects the ministry's keenness on scientific and medical events to promote the performance of all staffs of

the medical profession. He noted biomedical laboratory professions are among "the biggest groups in the field of health care."

Meanwhile, the head of the ministry's Directorate of Medical Laboratories Services Dr Doaa Al-Khaldi addressed the event saying it was part of the efforts to keep pace with the latest scientific techniques in the field. The conference seeks through lectures and workshops to highlight the crucial role played by the laboratories professions, she added. Khaldi noted that the total 145 laboratories in the Kuwaiti hospitals are provided with the latest advanced equipment in the world. — KUNA
