In this regard, LOYAC's board chairperson, Farea Al-Saqqaf said that the trip will be organized in collaboration with Lebanon's LOYAC and that the project's first phase aims at helping over 120 children of Syrian refugees to overcome psychological problems they suffer from as a result of the war.

She added that the project will also provide those children with education and therapy through music and art. Al-Saqqaf explained that Al-Fa'our camp included 220 Syrian families and 600 children and that six teachers from the camp were being trained to teach the program with hopes to double them within two years.
