

CHRISSY TEIGEN STRUGGLES TO WORK OUT

Chrissy Teigen has hinted she struggles to work out. The 31-year-old model - who has 14-month-old daughter Luna with her husband John Legend - is aware she should exercise more for "mental reasons" as well as physical, and while she thinks she "needs" to attend fitness classes with health guru Simone De La Rue she finds parking a problem, which easily puts her off the idea of exercising. Speaking in the new issue of Marie Claire magazine about her fitness plan, the brunette beauty - who confessed to having previously battled with postpartum depression - said: "I know I should exercise for mental reasons ... I need to see Simone De La Rue; I always feel great after I see her. In LA, there's never any parking. So for someone who doesn't already love working out, nothing's selling you on it." And the 'Lip Sync Battle USA' co-host - who is joined on the program by LL Cool J - has hinted she will not partake in any dance sessions to help her tone up because she has claimed she "can't dance" and doesn't take to difficult choreography well, although she can twerk. She added: "I can't dance. I don't take choreography very well. I will twerk." Chrissy has recently joined forces with beauty brand BECCA on her own cosmetic product titled BECCA x Chrissy Teigen Glow Face Palette earlier this year, and the star has admitted she will let her child experiment with "everything crazy under the sun" when she is older, to make her appreciate her natural beauty. Speaking previously about if she will guide Luna with fashion and beauty advice, she said: "I want her to appreciate her natural beauty. She's going to want to test everything crazy under the sun. ONE DIRECTION TO REUNITE FOR GRENFELL TOWER CHARITY SINGLE

One Direction could reunite for the Grenfell Tower charity single. The boy band are currently on an extended hiatus while they work on their solo careers, but it looks like a reunion could be happening sooner than expected as Liam Payne and Louis Tomlinson have already agreed to appear on the track, while Niall Horan and Harry Styles are desperately trying to clear their schedules for the gig. A source told The Sun newspaper: "If all four [One Direction] came on board, it would be as solo acts as Liam has to record in the US." It's thought Rita Ora, Robbie Williams, Louisa Johnson, James Arthur, Emeli Sande, Craig David, urban grime artists Stormzy and Skepta, and sixties legends The Who have agreed to feature on the single after Simon Cowell reached out to them. The 57-year-old music mogul - who lives close to the tower block in west London which was destroyed in an inferno on Wednesday (14.06.17) leaving at least 17 residents dead and dozens more injured - contacted numerous record labels the day after the horrific blaze to compile a list of artists to record on the single in a bid to raise money to help anyone affected by the disaster. Simon plans to have the song - which has not yet been chosen - ready for release at the start of next week with all proceeds going to the families. He said: "We will record it hopefully and finish it today. We already started to get a lot of people calling in saying, 'of course we would love to do it.' I do genuinely believe this will make a difference." The 'X Factor' judge - who has three-year-old son Eric with his partner Lauren Silverman - would be appalled with himself if he didn't do anything to try and help the victims of the devastating incident which has left hundreds of people homeless. Artists who could be involved in the charity record include those signed to his Syco label, such as Little Mix, Camila Cabello, Labrinth, and Noah Cyrus.

Amy Lee struggled to get work as movie score writer

Evanescence singer Amy Lee struggled to get into the movie songwriting business. The 35-year-old singer recently penned the song called 'Speak to Me' for 'Game of Thrones' star Emilia Clarke's upcoming thriller 'Voice from the Stone', but it has taken the 'Everybody's Fool' hitmaker a long time to get her work noticed and she has had a lot of her work rejected. Speaking exclusively to BANG Showbiz, she said: "I felt like [movie song writing] was a very hard wall to knock down. I've been trying to write music for film for some time and it's very difficult. I've been trying for a long time. I've written for many a film and the song didn't get used. But it's happening more for me now." Amy doesn't want to name the films that said no to her just in case gets offered something further down the line. She said: "I kinda hate to say what ones [didn't] because I don't want to burn the bridges for next time." Amy - who has two-year-old son Jack with her husband Josh Hartzler - also admitted that women are "over-sexualized" in Hollywood, however, she feels proud that more and more "strong" females are becoming powerful due to their success in the workplace and not just for their looks. She said: "Yes, women are over-sexualized. Everything is over-sexualized. But we're in an era where a strong woman is seen as a powerful thing and they don't have to look like something specific to have success.
