KHARAFI COMES 1ST AT QATAR'S EQUESTRIAN COMPETITION

DOHA: Kuwaiti rider Ali Al-Kharafi has won the first place in the jumping 5th international equestrian competition 'Chi Al-Shaqab' in Qatar, 2-4 March. Kharafi on Thursday won the jumping category 145cm with 56.88 seconds, followed by Qatar's Mubarak Al-Rumihi, 57.60

seconds. Qatari rider Nasser Al-Ghazli was third with 57.88 seconds, then Saudi Olympic athlete Ramzi Al-Duhami, 79.79 seconds. In the Jumping CSI 3 stars, 130 cm, Kharafi came third with 32.12 seconds, behind a Columbian rider who won first place with 31.02 seconds.

Duhami was second, 31.72 seconds, as Kuwaiti female rider A'esha Al-Qaoud came fifth 34.58, behind Saudi Arabia's Abudl-Karim Abar, 34.07. Up to 160 world top riders and 240 horses from 35 countries are taking part in the three-day equestrian competition. —KUNA
