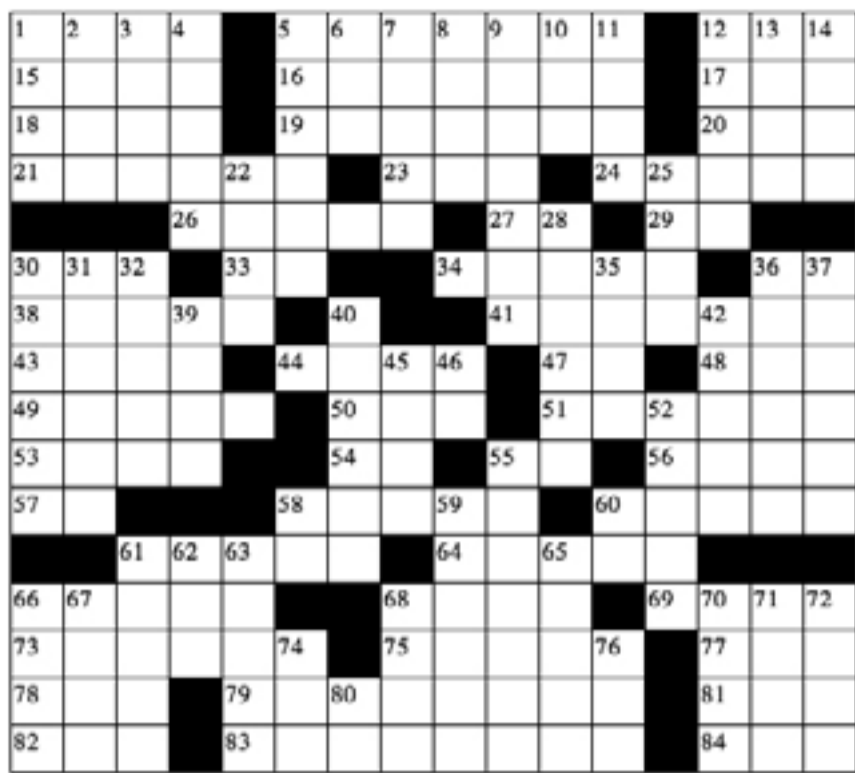

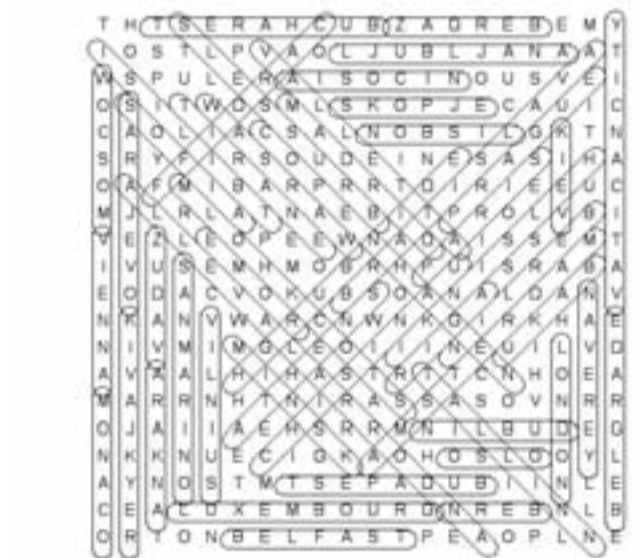
Find and circle all of the car parts that are hidden in the grid. The remaining letters spell the name of an additional car part.
