Gosling finds it 'hard' to talk about new movie

The 36-year-old actor admits it is strange to be promoting his film at a time when the US has been left in turmoil thanks to the impact of devastating hurricanes, and the tragic shooting at the Route 91 Harvest Festival in Las Vegas on Sunday which saw 59 people killed and hundreds injured - but understands why people also need to focus on lighter subjects. Speaking to talk show host Jimmy Kimmel on Tuesday a day after the presenter gave a heartfelt monologue about the mass killing in his home city - Ryan said: "I really appreciate what you said the other night about want-

ing to come out and tell jokes and be light, but it is getting harder and harder to do that." You think about all the, so many people suffering right now and all the victims of all these hurricanes and obviously this shooting and the earthquakes. "It's strange to be out talking about a film. I can't imagine how you must feel like being from Las Vegas." The pair then traded stories about time in Las Vegas, with the host admitting he hadn't realized what an "interesting" place it was until he moved away. He said: "I never realized it was an interesting place to be from until I moved away from

there and people said, 'Wow, what an interesting place to be from.' "The 49-year-old presenter insisted he had largely had a normal childhood, but with few exceptions. He explained: "Instead of 9:00 to 5:00, your mom or dad might work midnight to 8:00 a.m." Jimmy was reduced to tears on his show on Monday as he called for tighter gun control laws in the wake of gunman Stephen Paddock opening fire with an arsenal of weapons. He said: "It's the kind of thing that makes you want to throw up or give up."



Celine Dion broke down on stage

The 49-year-old singer has called Nevada home since kicking off her residency at Caesars Palace in 2003, so it was hardly surprising that she was reduced to tears on Tuesday night as she paid tribute to the victims of the shocking incident, which claimed the lives of 59 people, at the Route 91 Harvest Music Festival. Speaking to the crowd, the 'Think Twice' hitmaker said: "I hope that you're doing OK... before we start the show, I need to talk to you for a moment. "I never start the show like this but tonight is very different. For me it's: 'Can I still do my show?' Should I still do my show only two days after the nightmare?" The audience fell completely silent as the 'My Heart Will Go On' songstress wiped tears away from her face as she revealed that all the proceeds from the concert would go directly to the families affected by the horrendous attack, which left over 500 injured. As she belted out song after song, Celine - who sadly lost her husband Rene Angelil to cancer last year - told the concert goers that the victims were looking down on



them. Celine may have continued with her shows for the fans, but Jennifer Lopez has decided to take a different approach as she has postponed three dates of her Las Vegas residency at the Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino in the wake of the shooting.

Liam Payne 'hated' life in One Direction at times

The 24-year-old singer - who starred in the popular boy band alongside Niall Horan, Harry Styles, Louis Tomlinson, and previously, Zayn Malik - has admitted he broke down in tears when a family meal was disturbed by a clumsy cameraman, who pushed his mother over by accident. Recalling his lowest ebb, the 'Strip That Down' hitmaker told the Daily Star newspaper: "I just wanted a burger with my parents. 'I cried my eyes out. I thought, 'I can't do this' and I really hated my life.'" Meanwhile, Liam previously revealed that he struggled during his time in One Direction, because the band members could rarely leave their hotel while touring. The

singer admitted that their fans were so passionate about the group, it made it virtually impossible for them to step outdoors when they were on the road. He shared: "It sent me a bit AWOL at one point, if I'm honest. I can remember when there were 10,000 people outside our hotel. We couldn't go anywhere. It was just gig to hotel, gig to hotel. And you couldn't sleep, because they'd still be outside. "People were speaking to me about mental health in music the other day, and that's a big issue. Sometimes you just need some sun, or a walk."

The 25-year-old singer-songwriter was seen locking lips with Brandon Flynn the '13 Reasons Why' star on the streets of New York City, where they were also spotted grabbing dinner together at Catch NYC and enjoying the sights and sounds of the Big Apple. Sam and Brandon, 23, held hands and enjoyed the sunshine as they walked around Greenwich Village. The duo have also recently been liking each other's posts on social media, with Sam leaving a kiss underneath one of Brandon's posts which spoke out in support of the LGBTQ community. Despite this, Sam claimed in a recent interview that he's still "very, very single". In fact, the British star said he is more single now than he was prior to the release of his debut album 'In the Lonely Hour', which came out
