



Kim Kardashian wants to hire more security

The 'Keeping Up With The Kardashians' star admits to still suffering from anxiety after she was robbed at gunpoint in Paris last year and is considering increasing the number of people on her security team to help her get a better night's sleep. She said: "I just have anxiety, are you sure it's safe here? Ever since Paris I just go through this worst case scenario thing in my head. I think for my own piece of mind I'm going to fly out like four more security - just to like stay outside my room when I'm sleeping, I know it sounds crazy but I just can't sleep at night." And the 36-year-old television personality admits her anxiety has stopped her even wanting to go out for dinner with her husband Kanye West. Speaking on the family's E! reality show, she added: "I have such anxiety just going places. I just don't want to be in the

mix like I used to ... Kanye's like, 'Let's go out to dinner' and I'm like, 'I can't, I can't enjoy myself.' "I think I have to get out of my shell but I don't want to, I like living this more chill life. I've become socially awkward for sure ... I am so afraid of everything, anxiety, pressure." And Kim had previously blamed her social media activity for causing the Paris robbery as she believes it gave the burglars the information that she was home alone. She said at the time: "What I think happened now, after like thinking about it so much, is that there was probably a group of guys that were following us the entire trip. I was Snapchatting that I was home and that everyone was going out."

Crawford 'more concerned' about daughter driving



The 51-year-old supermodel has defended her daughter's decision to begin her modeling career at 16-years-old but admits she wishes she could have "pushed it off" for a year or two. Speaking to reporters at a charity event in Detroit, she said: "My daughter just got her driver's license. I'm a lot more concerned about her driving by herself than her entering the world of modeling. The great thing for my kids is that I know a lot about that world. I feel like, who better to help guide them than me? ... In some ways, I wish I could have pushed it off a year or two. But she's 16. That's how old I was when I started, which is young, but in fashion that's kind of the normal age when people start." Cindy and Kaia walked during the Versace's Spring/Summer 2018 fashion show but they refused to do so together. Cindy revealed: "I was booked before Kaia - I don't think Donatella [Versace] even knew that Kaia was doing shows and we had been talking for months about how many of us could get there for that tribute to [her brother] Gianni. "When Kaia got the part she said, 'Wait, are we going out together?' I said, 'I hope not, I don't want to stand next to you, I want to stand with the women my age.'" However, Cindy - who also has son Presley Gerber with her husband Rande Gerber - was honored to walk in the same show as Kaia as she doesn't think it will happen again. She added: "It was pretty cool, that probably won't happen again, to be in the same show."

Charlie Puth turned down 'overwhelming' American Idol

The 'We Don't Talk Anymore' hitmaker was "honored" to be asked to be a judge on the talent show but admits he had to turn it down when "life got crazy". He told Entertainment Tonight: "The schedule got too overwhelming. It's nothing to do with [the network] ... ABC is wonderful and I told them I would love to be in business with them in the future. [I was in talks] and then things in my life got crazy. "I can't wait to watch it. It's a huge honour that they asked me. The fact that they would even ask me to be a part of it is just beyond flattering because it's a show I grew up watching and I know it's going to be amazing without me." It comes after Katy Perry - who will be a judge on 'American Idol' - championed Charlie and Lionel Richie, who has been given the job, to

take up the remaining seat. She shared: "I'm really pulling for Lionel, because I think Lionel Richie is an icon ... If you've ever seen or met Lionel, he just knows how to charm the whole room. His presence brightens the whole room. Charlie Puth is somewhat new to the general public of America. He has his own big fanbase, but I think he's really talented and Attention is one of my favorite things. He's young, fresh, cool, hip." And Katy - who is joined by Luke Bryan on the judging panel - will not be listening to any "sob stories" from the show's contestants. She said: "Sob stories come second for me. I just want to give constructive criticism - if you don't got the goods, you don't got the goods."



Dolly Parton always takes 'crazy glue' with her



The 71-year-old singer is known for her extravagant fashion sense, and the music icon has revealed she has a selection of cosmetic products she makes sure she has on her in case of a beauty emergency. Speaking about her backstage beauty essentials, the busty blonde said: "Tissue and some crazy glue in case I flip a fingernail, a little flat mirror in case I have to fix an eyelash or something, and a few cosmetic things for if I have to take a little break." Although the '9 to 5' hitmaker has "a few" cosmetics on hand when she is performing, she still believes she is "low maintenance" because she spends an "hour and a half" getting ready prior to gracing the stage. When asked if she is high maintenance, the 'Jolene' artist said: "Yeah, I actually am to be honest. Hugh Hefner's life will be honored at a memorial

The late Playboy magazine founder - who passed away last month at the age of 91 - will have his life celebrated by his good friends at the service next month at the Playboy Mansion. Several celebrities and former Playboy models are expected to attend, RadarOnline.com reports. It comes after it was revealed Hugh's extended family and friends are planning to hold a memorial to remember him. A source said at the time: "The funeral on Saturday was so top-secret and his friends did not get to say goodbye. So they are gathering this week to have their own sort of memorial service. His extended family and friends are hoping to have the memorial at the Playboy mansion, but nothing is set in stone yet." Hugh's widow Crystal recently broke her silence on her husband's death, where she spoke of his "kind and humble soul". In a statement, she said: "I haven't been able to bring myself to write most people back to thank them for their condolences. I am heartbroken. I am still in disbelief. "He was an American hero. A pioneer. A kind and humble soul who opened up his life and home to the world. I felt how much he loved me. I loved him so much. "I am so grateful. He gave me life. He gave me direction. He taught me kindness. I will feel eternally grateful to have been by his side, holding his hand, and telling him how much I love him." Hugh was laid to rest last month at Los Angeles' Westwood Village Memorial Park, where he was buried next to Marilyn Monroe, a space which he is reported to have purchased for \$75,000 in 1992.
