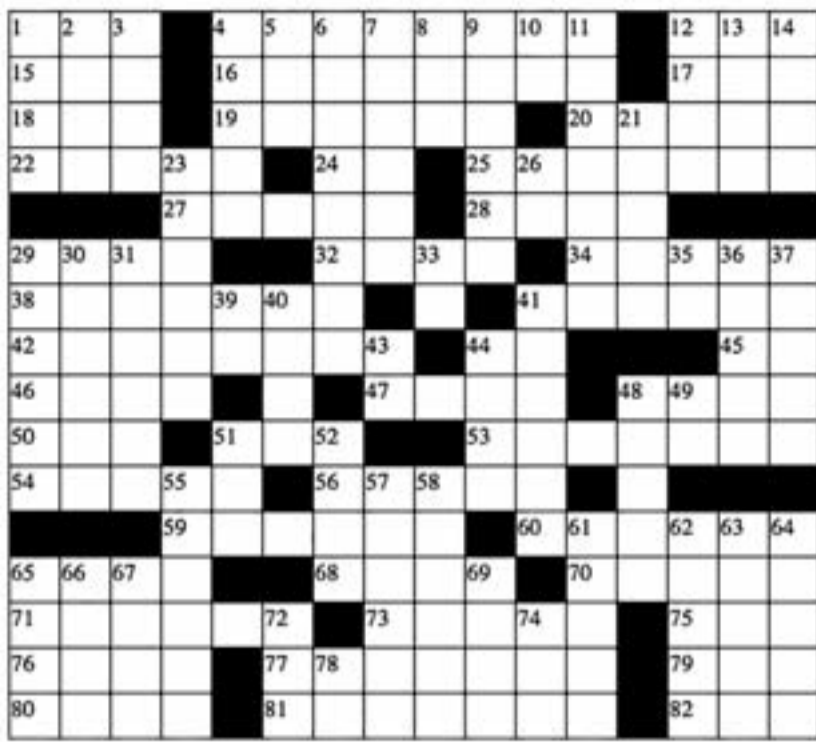

Wordsearch Puzzle

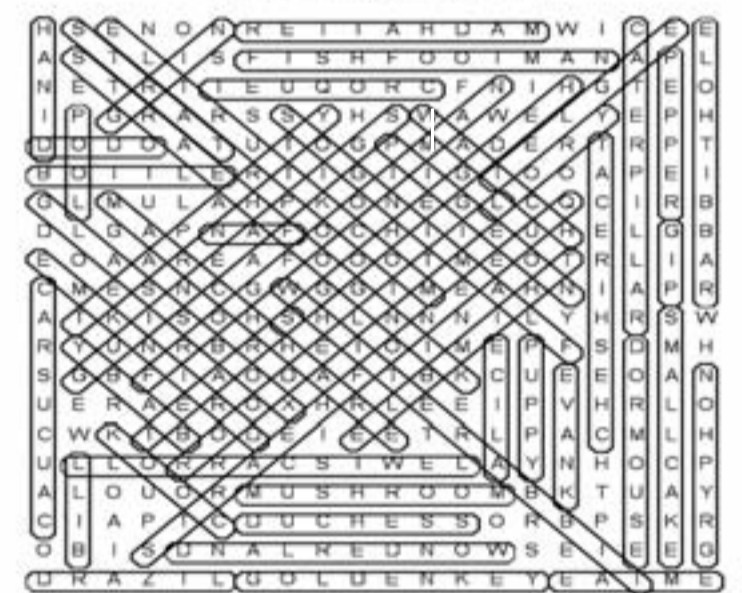
