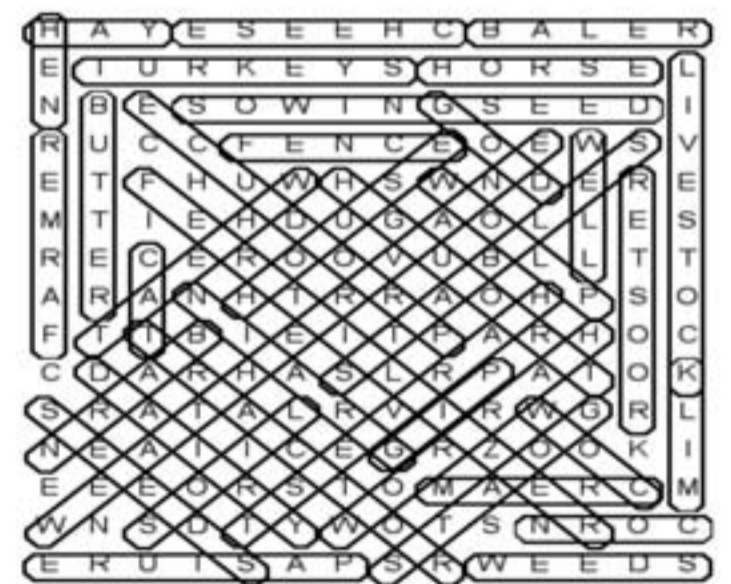
Wordsearch Puzzle
