A WARRANT HAS BEEN ISSUED FOR KATY PERRY'S ALLEGED STALKER

Last year, Katy, 36, was granted a temporary restraining order against a man named William Terry, who showed up at Katy's property after reportedly harassing her family on social media. He was charged with trespassing and was due in court in Los Angeles last week but was a no-show. TMZ reports that a bench warrant has been issued over Terry's failure to appear in court. Katy, her fiancé Orlando Bloom, their daughter Daisy Dove, and Orlando's nine-year-old son

Flynn have all been covered by a protective order against Terry, who is "believed homeless and living in a silver Buick sedan". In her initial filing in September, Katy said: "I do not know him. He is a complete stranger who trespassed on my property, is stalking me and who threatened my family." The singer listed the last date of harassment as September 8, when she alleged William "jumped the fence of my home in the Beverly Hills area". She added: "Security ordered [William] to leave.

When he refused, he was placed under citizen's arrest and then formally arrested for criminal trespass by the LAPD." The man allegedly told Katy's security he intended to enter the home, and the 'Daisies' singer also accused him of making threats on social media. She explained: "William has made threats on Twitter including that he wants to 'snap Orlando Bloom's neck' as well as lewd posts about me. He has entered my property and poses a violent threat to all of us." Katy finished her filing by claim-

ing she is "in immediate fear" for her own safety, as well as the safety of her family and friends. She said: "I do not know if this person owns or possesses any firearms or other weapons. I have great fear that he does or may have access to weapons. I am in immediate fear for my own safety, that of my partner, my newborn child, our family, and friends."

The 'Fleabag' creator picked up the huge sum between March 2019 and March 2020 after being hired to work on the 'No Time To Die' Bond screenplay. A source told The Sun newspaper's Bizarre column: "This really is a landmark moment for her which makes her one of the world's most sought after talents in TV and movies." Phoebe's £7million earnings are a reflection of just how far she's come over the past five years, and a sign of her huge potential to earn tens of

The 'Formation' singer announced last month that her BeyGOOD Foundation were teaming up with NAACP to help people who need assistance with their accommodation amid the coronavirus pandemic and now they are officially taking applications for \$5,000 grants. BeyGOOD Foundation announced on Instagram: "Housing assistance is here. Online applications start today for those impacted by the housing crisis caused by the pandemic. Go to @naacp.org for more info and to apply for the \$5K grants (sic)" The initiative will help 100 African American households who have got behind on their rent or mortgages due to income struggles amid the global health crisis. TAYLOR-JOY SAYS HER SUCCESS HAS BEEN OVERWHELMING

Anya Taylor-Joy has been overwhelmed by the popularity of 'The Queen's Gambit'. The 24-year-old actress stars in the hit Netflix series as chess prodigy Beth Harmon and explained how she was taken aback when seeing herself on a billboard in Los Angeles advertising the show. Anya recalled: "After quarantining I was still very jet-lagged so went for a walk at four in the morning and ended up on Sunset Boulevard and there was a giant billboard of my face. "I have never experienced that before in my life and promptly turned around and walked away because it was too much." Anya explained that her character's "passion" for chess has helped make the 1960s set series so successful. Speaking during an appearance on tonight's episode of 'The Graham Norton Show', she said: "I think it is a few different things. It is a story of redemption and it's nice to know you can overcome your demons in that way, but also passion is just exciting. "When you see how passionate she is about chess it just draws you in. And it's really pretty to look at." The 'Emma' star also told her fellow guest - former 'Great British Bake Off' host Mel Giedroyc - that she had watched episodes of the hit baking show during the "intense experience" of playing Beth. Anya said: "Being in Beth's headspace the whole time was quite an intense experience and I had never seen 'Bake Off' before, so I clung to it for the whole time - I watched it from the very beginning, so you were right there with me the whole time." The 'Witch' star previously revealed she learned to speak English when she moved to the UK from Argentina at the age of six thanks to J.K. Rowling's 'Harry Potter' novels. She said: "I wanted to go home, and in my six, seven-year-old mentality I thought my parents would have to take me back if I didn't speak the language. "My uncle would sit me down with the Harry Potter books, so all my language when I was young was quite precocious because I was learning from these books." She then jokingly added: "I was very well versed in spells from a very young age."



ELLEN DEGENERES WILL RETURN TO WORK TOMORROW



The star's self-titled talk show has been airing reruns since 10 December after the 62-year-old presenter was diagnosed with coronavirus but filming was due to resume on 4 January at the Warner Bros. lot. However, rising cases of the virus and the fact Southern California's hospitals are overstretched made the date untenable, but it has now been confirmed production will star next week, but without a studio audience. Other restrictions will be in place, including Ellen being joined only by a skeleton staff and crew, with a goal to minimize the number of employees needed at the show's offices at any

given time. However, the studio have confirmed all crew members will be paid during the modified production schedule following previous uncertainty in the early days of the first lockdown in 2020. Like Ellen's show, 'Dr. Phil' will also resume production next Monday from its Paramount Studios set but it will feature a live audience on Zoom. The current situation in California has seen night time talk show hosts Jimmy Kimmel and James Corden return to broadcasting from their homes this week. Opening his program on Monday night, Jimmy laughed: "Hi, I'm Jimmy, I'm the host of this house. Thanks for watching from

your house. This is our first show of the new year. And exciting new year. 2021 is in, 2020 is out. "I've been bubbling with enthusiasm, optimism. I've been ready for a return to normalcy. And here I am doing the show from my kitchen again. "Because there's a deadly virus, that seems to be living in LA now. It seems to have taken permanent residence here. I believe it lives across the street from me in Kendall Jenner's old house." And James was also back in his own garage set at home, where he had broadcast a lot of his own show earlier in the pandemic during the summer.
